

OSSAA Officials Insurance Program 2017-2018

(Revised May 2017)

OSSAA Insurance Programs for officials are designed to offer supplemental insurance coverage to meet the needs of today's game officials. This coverage is designed to assist in the event of a major claim. After the official's primary health insurance has been applied; the OSSAA policy may be used to help meet remaining expenses. There is a \$2500 deductible for the OSSAA policy that must be met in addition to any deductible that has been met by the primary coverage. The OSSAA policy does carry a clause involving reimbursement for game fees missed due to an official suffering an injury while officiating that prohibits an official from fulfilling the remainder of their schedule.

Supplemental insurance coverage is provided through Loomis and LaPann, Inc. This coverage is provided to all registered officials of the OSSAA while working scheduling interscholastic contests or scrimmages including travel to and from a contest that is under the jurisdiction of the OSSAA.

The policy also includes liability coverage as follows: 3,000,000 General Aggregate and 1,000,000 Occurrence.

If injured, an official, prior to leaving the site, should confirm the injury with the home administration and a member of the officiating crew.
